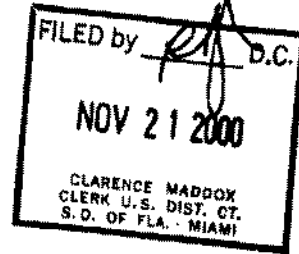

THE COURT has reviewed the motion, the pertinent portions of the record and is fully advised in the premises.


