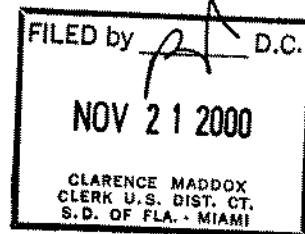

THE COURT has reviewed the motion, the pertinent portions of the record and is otherwise fully advised in the premises.


